This month I thought I would talk to you about a Waitrose project called 'Waitrose Foundation' created in 2005 with the goal of building a better future for the farm workers of South Africa who pick our fruit. Instead of funding through a price premium, Waitrose in conjunction with suppliers, exporters and farmers - pass a percentage of profits into a trust to pay for educational, social and healthcare projects selected by workers committees. In the first four years the project has raised over £2m for 100 projects benefiting over 16,000 workers.

Part of the Foundation is the Cederberg Wine Farm, uniquely situated in some of the Cape's highest vineyards lying at over 1,000m. The vineyards are managed sustainably with great sensitivity for the local environment. They produce two superb wines created by the skilled winemaker David Nieuwoudt. Enjoy!

CEDERBERG WAITROSE FOUNDATION CHENIN BLANC 2008 SOUTH AFRICA £7.99

A classy Chenin Blanc made by Cederberg for Waitrose foundation. It's a deliciously fruity white that's dry with peachy aromas and flavours. This wine has mouth-watering acidity yet remains extremely well balanced.

CEDERBERG WAITROSE FOUNDATION SHIRAZ 2008 SOUTH AFRICA £7.99

A fabulous red with smooth blackberry and black pepper notes. A well structured medium to full bodied wine with subtle spice and wild berries on the finish. Enjoy with those heartier red meat dishes.

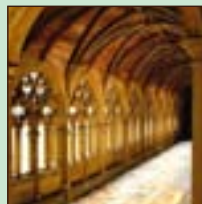

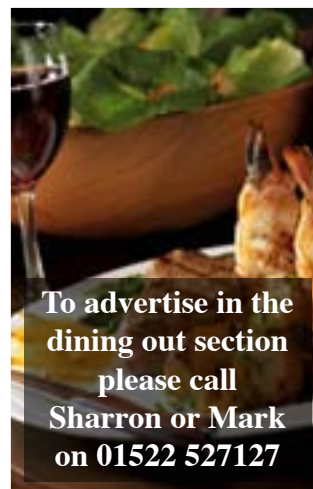
